Recently, the Vjosa River in Albania become a national park after 8 years of campaigning and the involvement of Patagonia in a partnership with government and the IUGNwork has been intense, with Patagonia playing a very hamdand leadership role in assisting to drive the pragramel as providing funding through it's 1% for the Planet grant giving mmitment of the Patagonia Board and Gollert.

Occasional trips to other locations in the Balkans are also likely as the aim is to roll the ipatelionodel of national park development to other ivers in the Balkans.
