# Rules and Regulations

From 11-13 February 2025, South Asian University (New Delhi) and the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) will convene the second Meghna Knowledge Forum (MKF II), under the theme of "Building community and ecosystem resilience to climate change".

#### **Deadline**

The call for submissions ends on **04 January 2025.** Late submissions will not be considered.

# **Judging**

The top 10 photos will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Clear interpretation of one of the MKF II themes
- High-quality image with a clear focus and good lighting
- · Conveys a story that evokes a mood or emotion

The panel consisting of IUCN Secretariat staff will reserve the right to make the final decision on the winning photos, based on the above criteria, in addition to votes received on IUCN Asia Facebook page.

## **Winning Photos**

Winning photos will be announced by 15 January 2025. They top ten selected photos will be displayed in an exhibition at MKF II during the event on 11-13 February 2025, showcased on IUCN Asia's Facebook page and included in the MKF proceedings.

The two top photo stories will receive funding to attend MKF II as an observer.

### **Your Rights**

Entrants retain ownership to any photograph they submit. However, each entrant grants IUCN a royalty-free and non-exclusive license to use and sub-license such photograph, for educational and non-commercial purposes.

Each use of the photograph will be credited with © NAME OF COPYRIGHT OWNER and the appropriate caption, if there is space.

In case natural, recognizable persons are depicted in a photograph submitted to this photo competition, each entrant shall ensure that these persons have given their consents for the described use of their images. This does not refer to photographs taken in public places where random members of the public are identifiable only hypothetically and to public persons acting in their public activities.
