#### **DID YOU KNOW...**

UK peatlands store half the carbon of that held in the entire Peruvian rainforest — yet cover only 3% of the area

THAT IS 20 TIMES AS MUCH CARBON AS IN UK WOODLANDS

Every year over 10 million tons of CO<sub>2</sub> escape from damaged peatlands; that is equal to two thirds of all greenhouse gas savings made by the UK each year

A further 5% loss of our peatlands would equate to the total UK anthropogenic (man-made) emissions for a whole year...






80% of UK peatlands are damaged as a result of past drainage.
