







Dear colleagues,

Following years of deliberations and negotiations, I am happy to inform you that a new national law on wastewater discharges was passed yesterday, to become binding as of today. This law, to be found under ENVXXI 12 (Art. IV), concerns all corporations operating in our country.

The new law states that:

Corporations will be entitled to 1 year to include this legislation into their operational management systems, after which they will face penalties if they do not comply.


