Mount Sanqingshan National Park displays a unique array of forested and fantastically shaped granite pillars and peaks concentrated in a relatively small area.

Remarkable granite rock formations combine with diverse forest and striking meteorological effects to create a landscape of exceptional scenic quality.

Most notable aspect is the concentration of shaped pillars and peaks.
