The third International Marine Protected Areas Congress due to take place from 21 to 27 October in Marseille and Corsica, is now approaching. Publishing the programme on www.impac3.org is a new milestone towards the Congress, paving the way for registrations (discount applicable until 20 August).

Unprecedented success in the call for papers:

In response to the call for papers, some 700 contributions were collected from across the oceans. Unsurprisingly, the host country France was the biggest contributor, accounting for about a quarter of abstracts received. The rest of Europe provided another quarter, followed by the Americas (approximately 20%), Africa and Asia
