Other suggestions for future engagement

When asked about future potential engagements (i.e. open-ended question)* respondents foresee a variety of ways to engage in IPBES (for instance* they propose to implement pilot projects to demonstrate IPBES findings* promote IPBES activities in their own* and mainstream IPBES work into their constituencies) and respondents foresee benefits from the IPBES work programme but ask for clarification of IPBES priorities before formally engaging in specific activities (Some respondents also wish that there should be a more active participation of stakeholders in the process of drafting the work programme)
