Key facts

- Recommended by IUCN for inscription on the World Heritage List in July 2008 at the World Heritage Committee in Quebec City, Canada, for its geological values.
- · An exceptional and dramatic display of mountain building through continental collision.
- Has been recognised as a key site for geological sciences since the 18th century.
- The clear exposure of the Glarus Overthrust a "magic line" where older rocks overlay younger rocks is a key, but not the only significant, feature.
- The exposures of the rocks below and above this feature are visible in three dimensions and, taken together, have made substantial contributions to the understanding of mountain building tectonics.
- The property is one of the few sites illustrating tectonic processes that can be regarded as being of Outstanding Universal Value.
